Fred Glass to address Catholic Business Exchange

Fred Glass, a prominent civic leader and head of Gleaners Food Bank, will address the November Catholic Business Exchange. His topic will be— Feeding the Hungry in Challenging Times. In 2022, he became the president and chief executive officer of Gleaners, the largest food bank in Indiana and one of the most respected in the national Feeding America Network. Before joining Gleaners, Fred served as vice president and athletic director for Indiana University, from 2009 through 2020, where he led a cultural and physical rebuilding of the athletic department. He served as president of the Indianapolis Capital Improvement Board where he led successful negotiations to keep the Colts in Indianapolis, regularly host NCAA Final Fours, develop what became Lucas Oil Stadium, and dramatically expand the Indiana Convention Center. Fred also led the effort for Indianapolis to host the Super Bowl, laying the groundwork for its successful 2012 bid. Previously, Fred served as Chief of Staff to former Indiana Governor Evan Bayh. The event is Friday November 21, at the Northside Events and Social Club. Mass is offered at 7am and the program will be finished by 9am. Cost for the program includes a great breakfast and is \$20 in advance for members and \$25 for non-members. Registration is required by 4pm, Tuesday November 18.
