The Scrutinies

As our OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) individuals approach full communion with the Catholic Church they experience three special rites known as The Scrutinies. These rites take place during the third, fourth, and fifth Sundays of Lent. This time of formation is a period of purification and enlightenment. It is a time to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect and to strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.

Each of the three rites is based on sacred Gospel Scripture. The first scrutiny relates to the encounter Jesus has with the Samaritan woman at the well. Here, Jesus offers himself as the "living water." The second scrutiny comes from Jesus' healing of the man blind from birth. In this Gospel Jesus gives himself as the "light of the world." The third scrutiny, based on the raising of Lazarus from the dead, reveals Jesus as the "resurrection and the life".

Each rite involves the elect being called forward, and the parish to silently pray for them. The priest recites a prayer of exorcism which is intended to help purify the elect from sinful desires. These prayers as well as the laying on of hands are intended to enlighten the elect to the Word and Grace of God.

These rites are also extended to the parishioners for reflection and renewal.

We, the parishioners of St. Ann Catholic Church, are called to worship God, learn and share our faith as we serve the needs of all our neighbors.
